Use this information to determine the best 3 plans for you. You will then contact the provider directly and notify them that you want your Medicare Part D insurance through their company.

SPECIAL NOTICE:

There have been reports of unethical people calling seniors identifying themselves as Medicare Part D Program providers. They are obtaining personal information and then using that information to access checking accounts to steal money. **DO NOT RESPOND** to anyone who calls you on your telephone identifying themselves as representing any Medicare Part D provider companies.

To ensure that you are not the victim of a scam you should be the one to initiate the telephone call to the Medicare program provider.
